

Become acquainted with contemporary Israel, its history, heritage, cuisine and culture.



- Visit Nazareth Set in the Lower Galilee, Israel's biggest Arab city, Nazareth, is a fascinating place. It combines traditional, simple Arabic charm, Christian history, and grand old Arabic architecture. Nazareth is home to many important early Christian sites, including the Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, and the Synagogue Church, as well as an authentic, living Arab souk (market).

- Wine tasting at Tishbi Winery Tishbi Winery was founded by Baron Edmund de Rothschild and the Chamiletzki family who were given the name Tishbi by the famous poet Chaim Nachman Bialik in 1925. Four generations have passed and Jonathan Tishbi still remembers harvesting by hand in his family's vineyards and bringing the wagons of grapes to be pressed in the nearby winery that still follows the traditional growing methods passed on to him by father and grandfather.
- Continue to Caesarea Bird Mosaic Discover the Bird Mosaic located in a public park in Caesarea. The mosaic was originally part of a large 6th century mansion. In 1955, archaeologists excavated a hilltop 500 meters outside of the Byzantine city wall in Caesarea. A large mosaic floor was discovered dating from the 6th Century CE.
- Finish the day at Aqueduct Beach The Aqueduct Beach, Caesarea is a beautiful and historic beach in Israel, where you can see the remains of a Roman aqueduct that supplied water to the ancient city of Caesarea. The beach is located a few kilometers north of the main archaeological park, and offers a stunning contrast between the golden sand, the blue sea, and the stone arches.

- Visit the museum at Yad Vashem, Israel's National Memorial to the Holocaust Tour this memorial to the darkest moment in the world and Jewish history, its children's memorial, and exquisite gardens. Yad Vashem is an unforgettable place of tribute and remembrance. You'll be guided by a member of the Yad Vashem staff.
- Lunch in the Old City (Meal is included)
- Tour Jerusalem's Old City and meet the people and places that make this place so unique In the Jewish Quarter, uncover the layers of Jewish history from the time of the First Temple until the present day. In the Christian Quarter, visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Throughout the tour explore the complexity of a city that is holy to the three major religions Judaism, Christianity, and Islam.

- Masada National Park Ascend the mountain from the east (via cable car) to explore Masada, scene of the epic stand by Jewish rebels at the end of the Great Revolt against Rome nearly 2,000 years ago. The new museum at the Visitor Center reveals the secrets of the daily life of the rebels, the story of the excavations, and how the site became one of Israel's most important symbols.

- Dead Sea Float At 1,300 feet below sea level, the Dead Sea is the lowest point on earth. Known in Hebrew as "The Sea of Salt", it is also one of the saltiest lakes in the world with about 34.2% salinity. This is a stunning, other-worldly landscape of shimmering blue water ringed by bare, orange and yellow hills. The waters of the Dead Sea hold a potent solution of minerals and salts that have strong healing properties. Together with its ethereal beauty, these health-giving minerals make the Dead Sea's beaches and spas popular vacation spots for Israelis and tourists alike.




Jaffa - A Window to The Middle East
